

The President's Stimulus Package will be giving **non taxable refunds** of up to \$600.00 for single people and of up to \$1200.00 to couples. People that **DO NOT** file an income tax **may want to file one this year** if they have income of \$3000 or more. Qualifying income includes Social Security Benefits, certain Railroad Retirement Benefits, certain veterans' benefits and earned income from wages, salaries, tips and self-employment. While these people may not be normally required to file a tax return because they do not meet the filing requirement, the IRS emphasizes **THEY MUST FILE A 2007 RETURN** in order to receive a rebate payment.

This rebate program will not affect a person's eligibility for any government entitlement programs, e.g. ConnPACE, Medicare Savings Program, Food Stamps etc.
