1. You must be a verifiable resident of Pomfret, CT – You must be either currently a senior in high school, enrolled as a post graduate in high school (full time) or an undergraduate student in college (minimum of nine credits per semester) and have resided in Pomfret for a minimum of five years.
2. You must provide written & signed (by the program supervisor) records that will verify that you have performed community service (volunteer-not paid) to the town of Pomfret in some capacity i.e., The Recreation Department, any of the little league or soccer programs, Owaneco lacrosse, girl scouts, boy scouts, senior citizen's, etc.
3. You must answer this year's essay question in writing to the best of your ability. (500 words or less)
