Both ***Red Sox games*** are sold out. ***After School Stay and Play program*** will run again this spring with Steve Guilbault. ***Babysitting Class*** scheduled for Mar. 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> from 3:30-6:30 pm. ***Easter Egg Hunt*** is scheduled for Mar. 31<sup>st</sup> with a rain date of Apr. 7<sup>th</sup>. Bev said the Young Marines would be able to help us again this year in hiding the eggs. ***The Player Development Basketball Clinic*** is Sat. Mar.24<sup>th</sup> at Pomfret School. Heather will help out again this year. ***Pepsi, Pitch, Hit & Run*** contest will be on May 6<sup>th</sup> at the Rec. Park.
